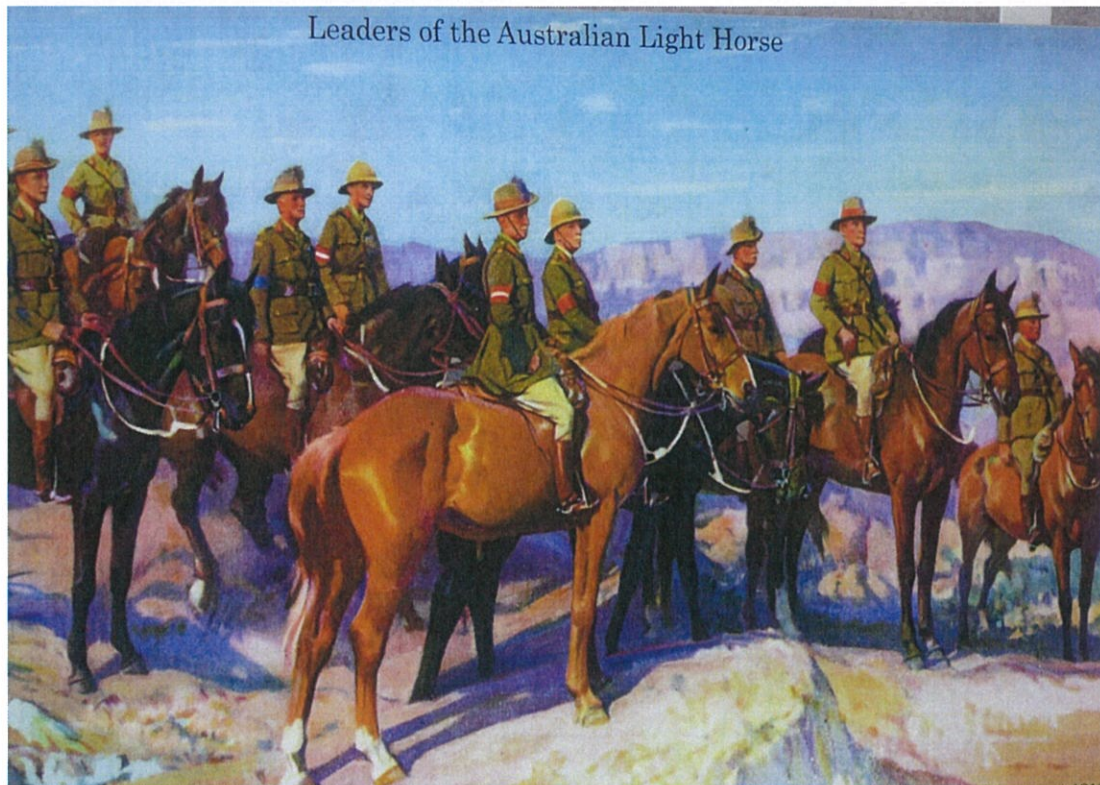

GCMG, KCB and the Upper Clarence Light Horse Established Tabulam 1885

Tuesday 31st October 2017 marks the 100th Anniversary of the Battle at Beersheba. A Memorial Service honouring the remarkable Chauvel of Tabulam and the Light Horse will commence at 5.00pm on the Tabulam Oval.

The service will pay tribute to Sir Harry, a boy from the bush who went on to become the greatest cavalry General of modern times.

At 6.00pm riders will re-enact the Charge at Beersheba.

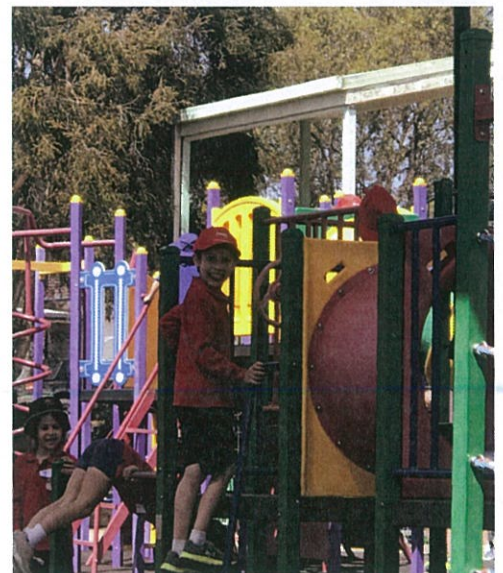

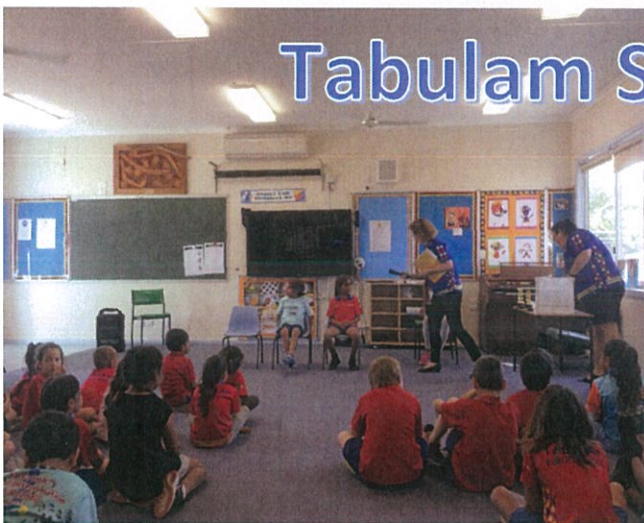
