In the event of a bushfire emergency and the school is required to evaluate whilst children are at school, the follow locations are where we will travel too according to where the bushfire is located.

- 1- Mummulgum Public School
- 2- Casino Public School
- 3- Drake Public School

If the bushfire was severe and we were evacuating for a long period of time, if possible, we would continue on to Casino Public School as we would have more room and been closer to facilities and services.

The school will act under the direction of emergency services advice and will only evacuate when directed too.

In the event of an evacuation, please monitor our Facebook page to get instant information and updates.

We have been advised that there is a strong possibility of Blue Green Algae in the river at Tabulam. Please be mindful when people are swimming in the river. Health risks associated with Blue Green Algae can be found on our Facebook page.

Intensive Swimming will begin in week 7, 25<sup>th</sup> November for 1 week. Please bring your permission note and \$10 to the front office ASAP.

All paperwork for children wishing to enrol in kindergarten at Tabulam Public School is due this Friday, 15 November. Please see me at the front office if you require assistance filling out the forms. I truly appreciate you getting this information in as early as possible as it allows for smooth school planning.


