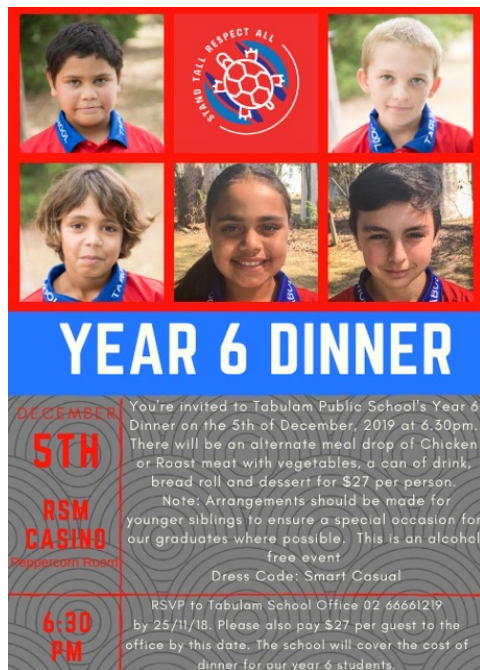

The position will be located at: **Tabulam Public School**

Tabulam Public School has an enrolment of 44 students with 80% Aboriginal enrolment. There are 2 mainstream classes which support students with a range of educational needs. The school promotes high expectations for all children, a connection to culture and works closely with local community. For further information please visit the school's website.

About the Role

School Learning Support Officers provide support for students with identified diverse learning needs including disability in classrooms and other learning environments under the direction and supervision of a teacher to support the achievement of educational outcomes. This support includes student welfare, health and wellbeing activities as required.

Position criteria

1. Demonstrated ability to work effectively as part of a team.
2. Ability to work with students with emotional, physical or intellectual disabilities.
3. Awareness of the needs of students with emotional, physical or intellectual disabilities.
4. Effective communication skills.
