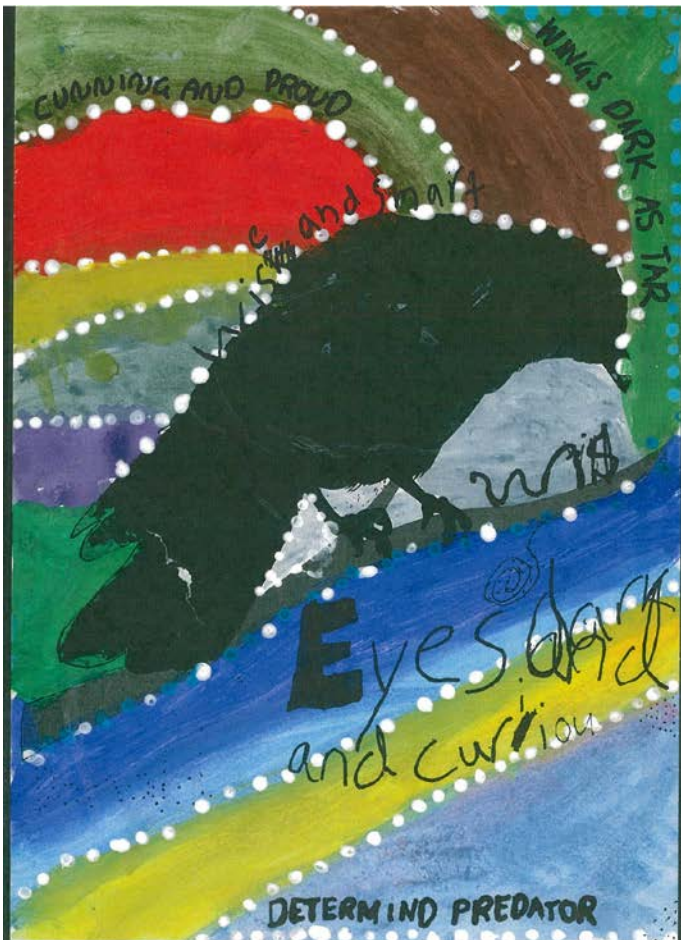

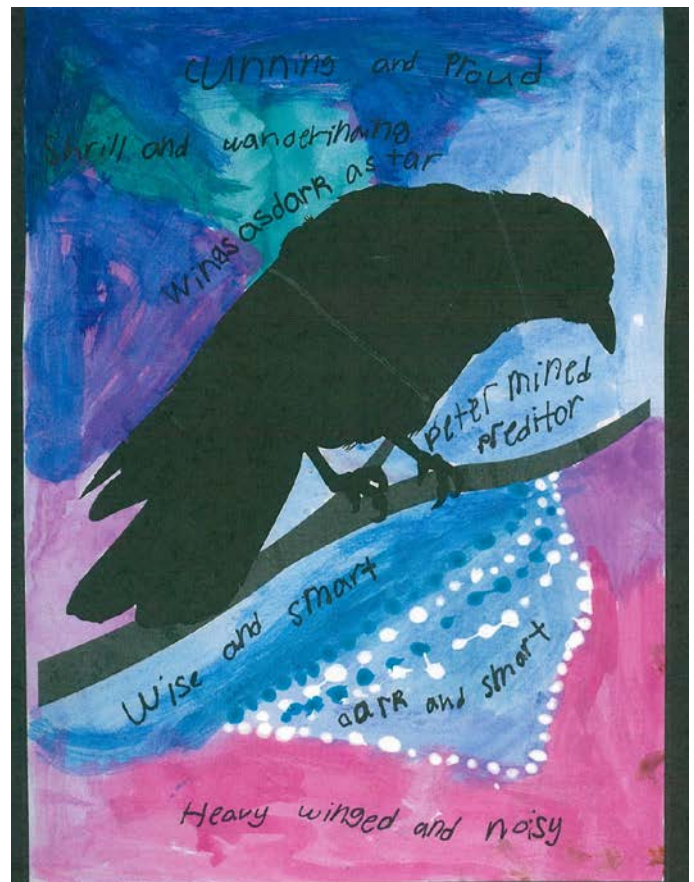
Year 3/4/5/6 have been developing

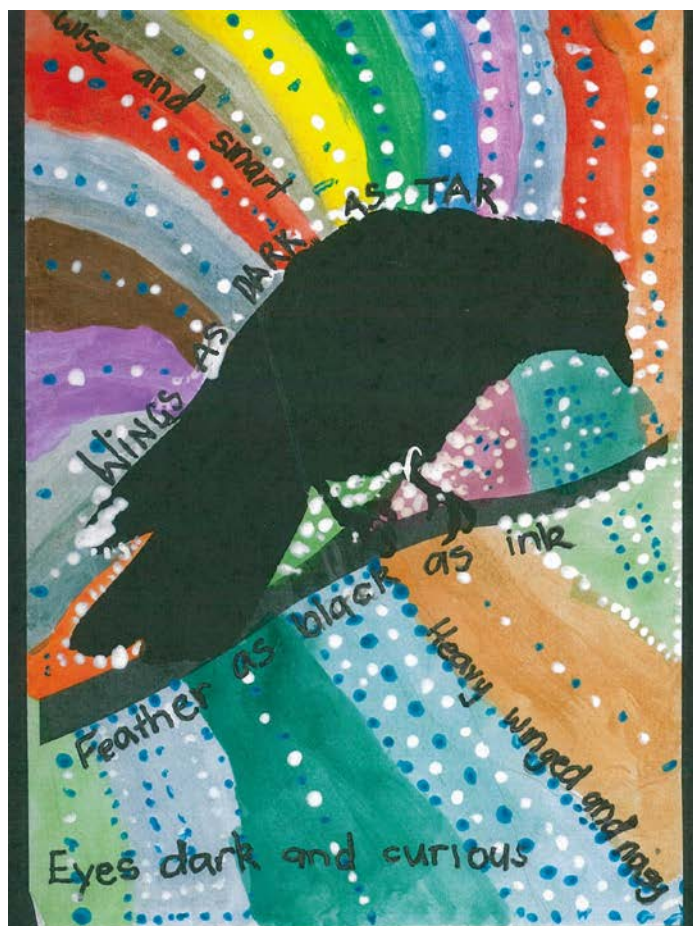
