Dear parents, carers and community members,

Welcome to **week 7** and a number of **building refurbishes** at Tabulam Public School. There is a great deal of scaffolding around at the moment and over the next couple of weeks the double storey building (which houses the canteen) will be reroofed as will the K/1/2 classroom. A number of other buildings will be getting new guttering and the Wahluhal Culture and History Centre will be having the old air coolers removed from the roof and some roofing panels replaced.

The **3/4/5/6 excursion** is coming up fast and we are pleased to announce that we will be using school funds to **reduce the cost to parents to \$100 per child**. We realise many people have had a number of costs due to the recent fires and want to ease the burden on families. The \$100 per child needs to be **paid as soon as possible** to ensure a place on the excursion. We need to notify the venue for accommodation and catering purposes.

With autumn upon us it is the **season for head lice**. Please be aware of checking your child's hair regularly. This is the season in which head lice thrive. If you find your child has nits or lice the hair needs to be treated before returning to school.

**Bike course for children:** Please find a flyer attached regarding a bike course for children on the **first Sunday in the school holidays (Sun 14<sup>th</sup> April)**. The bike course will be held at **Tabulam Public School 9am – 12pm**; Mrs Wilkinson will be supervising on the day. This is an excellent opportunity for students to learn some bike rules and also to get minor maintenance to their own bike. Students are **encouraged to bring their own bike** but there will be bikes and helmets available on the day.

**Service NSW** will be visiting Tabulam tomorrow 12th March at 21-29 Clarence St between 9am to 4pm. The Mobile Service Centres offer similar services to their physical sites including: Driver's licence, photo card applications and renewals, Driver Knowledge Tests, Working With Children Check applications, Applying for birth, death and marriage certificates, Cost of Living service to access more than 40 government rebates and savings.

At this morning's assembly **all students participated in a raffle** to receive donated school items which were delivered for the school by the St Vincent De Paul Society, Lismore. These items were donated by people around Lismore and a number of schools benefitted from the project. Students received one raffle ticket for each 10 dojo points they had accumulated. **All students** were drawn out of the raffle to choose one item, the items included **school bags and school resources to help with learning**.


- Renewing a driver licence or vehicle registration
