**Congratulations** to the following students who are all on **GOLD** level:-

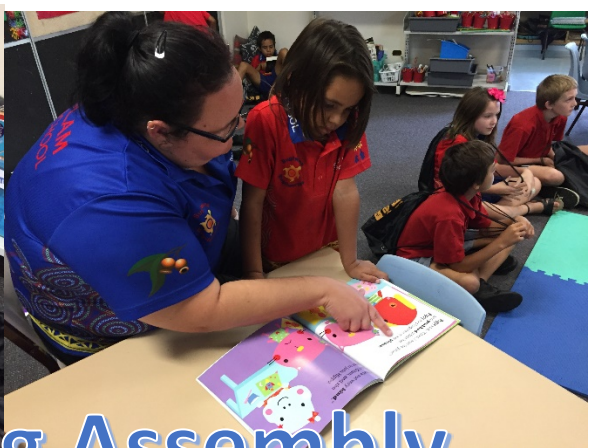
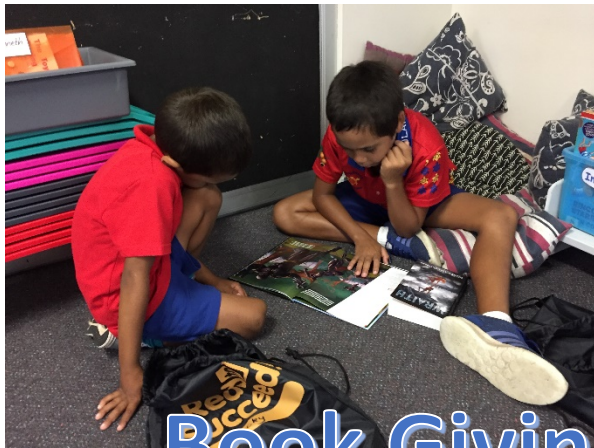
