<u>Level 3 restrictions Tabulam PS MUST follow as outlined by the</u> <u>Department of Education</u>

- Students and staff should not attend school if unwell, even with mildest symptoms of COVID-19. Any student or staff with COVID-19 symptoms should not return to school until they have received a negative test result and are symptom-free.
- Staff must be fully vaccinated to be on school grounds from the 8th of November.
- No excursions off site until further notice.
- Masks are mandatory for all adults on site and encouraged for children.
- No assemblies until further notice.
- Parents who drop off or pick up their children are encouraged to do this at the front gate. A staff member will be there to support this easy drop off and pick up method.
- Only essential visitors are permitted on school sites during these guidelines. If parents/carers require face to face contact or a school visit, they must come into the school office, are required to be well and COVID-19 symptom free, wear a face mask and follow sign in procedures.
